Private media

Our private Facebook group and Online Directory are tools that help us connect and share news within our church family.

Our **Private Facebook group** is a place for members and regular attenders to post church-related news, pictures and videos. Any unrelated or objectionable posts will be removed. If you have questions about this group or would like to be added, please contact a member of the Communications Committee.

Our **Online Directory** is shared with our members and regular attenders. Members control what information is shared in their profile. At any time, members can update their information or request updates. No profiles are listed for youth under age 18.

Social media and youth

Church staff and volunteers (i.e., Sunday School teachers and youth leaders) shall not accept friend requests from members under 18 years of age. Further, church members are strongly discouraged from having social media friendships with youth.
